The Chair and Secretary worked with the Steering Committee in preparing informational emails about service and online nominating ballots on the Academic Senate, during January, February, and early March.

The Chair and Secretary worked with the Steering Committee in on the Senate Standing Committees in preparing informational emails about service and full-time and adjunct, HEO, and CLT online committee preference forms for the Senate Standing Committees during late February to late March.

The Chair created a population scheme for the Standing Committees based on the committee preference forms and discussed it with the membership of the COC.

The slate of committee memberships was not presented at the April meeting, as it should have been, due to delays in finalizing the committee memberships, formatting errors in the document, and confusion as to the actual current membership on a couple of committees. It was forwarded to the Senate membership and voted on at the May meeting. Two new COC members, Barbara Rome and Kevin Kolack, were elected by floor vote. One (but apparently two, due to Paul Sideris and my extended terms expiring along with other members whose term expired in 2024) new member remains outstanding, to be elected from the floor at the September meeting.

Annual Timeline for the Committee on Committees

May: Introductory Meeting for newly-elected members, election of officers

Early to Mid-March: Ballots for FMAL (Faculty Member at Large [Senate] and Committee Preference Ballots for the committees of the Senate go out Fall Meeting: To outline the committee's work in the Spring Semester.

Mid to Late March: The committee meets one or more times to work out placement of faculty on the various committees, creating the slate that will be voted on at the Senate (the Senate Election is tabulated automatically

February: Invitations to serve on the Academic Senate and its committees go out early, a reminder late February

Early to Mid-April: The FMAL election results are made public, the Academic Senate votes on the slate of committee memberships

The chair has recently contacted Adam Volin and Raj Vaswani about the possibility of creating a Google Doc (or the equivalent) where changes in committee membership are incorporated and would automatically update both the Current Roster as well as the individual committee membership list on the QCC Senate (Committees) website and the webpage of each committee. Adam has suggested the creation of a Microsoft Teams group for the committee, which should help to address this issue, and will work with the committee during the coming academic year to implement it.
