Meeting Times:

The Awards and Scholarships Committee met **two times** (January 3rd, and May 9th) during the academic year 2017-2018 to evaluate and recommend nominations for awards and scholarships.

Accomplished Items: The committee reviewed a total of **304** applications/nominations. This includes 87 Continuing Academic Merit Scholarships reviewed in May for the Fall 2018 semester.

A. Special Awards: 7 recipients chosen out of 25 applicants

1. *John F. Kennedy Memorial Award (\$1500) – given to Mabely Salvador (out of seven nominees), graduating students who have demonstrated outstanding leadership in the college and the community.

2. *Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Award (\$1500) – given to Nazia Bonori (out of four applicants), a graduating student who has demonstrated exceptional leadership in promoting racial harmony and appreciation of cultural diversity;

3. *Ray Ricketts Memorial Award (\$150) - given to Sarah Aguire (out of 3 applicants), returning student (left college at one point) who exhibits exceptional scholarship and leadership;

4. *Incentive Awards - Day and Evening (\$250 each) – given to day and evening students:
Day: Shaleene Tulshi and Martha Martinez (out of six applicants)

Evening: Somattie Seonrain-Persaud and Jaylen Tompkins (out of five applicants) who have demonstrated outstanding academic performance and are working parents.

* The president’s office handles the JFK and MLK awards- the recipients’ names are printed in the commencement book and they are mailed a check, a certificate and a letter. The president’s liaison on the committee, Veronica Lukas, sends the information to Millie Conte of the presidents’ office.

Student Affairs handles the Ray Rickett’s award while Student Government handles the Day and Evening Incentive awards. The recipients’ names are printed in the commencement book and they are mailed a check, certificate and letter. Veronica Lukas sends the information to the VP for Student Affairs office.

B. Continuing Student Academic Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is given to current and continuing students who have demonstrated outstanding academic performance (a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 required). In the Fall 2017 semester awards of \$1,000 each were given to 65 new and continuing students. Additionally, two awards of \$500 were distributed. The committee reviewed 100 applications from continuing students and recommended 65. The applications of the qualifying incoming Freshmen are not reviewed by the committee. In the Spring 2018 semester awards of \$1,000 each were given to 118 students (new applicants as well as Fall 2017 applicants qualifying for continued funding in the Spring). Additionally, four awards of \$500 were given. The committee reviewed 79 applications for the Spring 2018 merit scholarship and recommended 56 for the scholarship.

Accomplishments

- 1. The committee reviewed 179 Continuing Academic Merit Scholarship applications, slightly above the 171 reviewed the previous year. We had 183 students receive a merit**

scholarship of \$1000, up from 140 the previous year. This number included 51 from new admissions for Spring 2018.

2. The list of final recipients of awards was received in digital format by the chair in late August. This list, from Charles Petz, continues to improve in readability.
3. The grading rubric that Shele Bannon originally designed continues to be vital in evaluating Continuing Academic Merit Scholarship essays. The simplified scales of 1-3 for Content and 1-3 for Grammar have made the evaluations easier. ***See Appendix 2 for details of the rubric.**
4. The Continuing Academic Merit Scholarship voting list was edited further by the financial aid office to include columns for both the registered credits for the previous and upcoming semester. Also, the Essay component was modified to include two columns (one for content and one for grammar) with a description of the grading scale for both. This has made the screening and evaluation process a lot easier.
5. The committee is again able to report on all of the awards and scholarships offered by the college *and their dollar amounts* (see Appendix 1). The data was obtained from Charles Petz, Database Manager, Office of Institutional Advancement.

Challenges

1. Obtaining data for the annual report of the committee in a timely manner could still be made more efficient.
2. Starting September 8, 2017, *Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges* closed its administrative offices to undergo a review of the organization. Because of this, they did not take nominations for 2018. Typically, our committee meets in March to go over Who's Who applications. This is why there was no March meeting during this academic year. This was also a factor in why the number of total applications/nominations was down this year (304) in comparison to last (324). Once Who's Who resumes accepting nominations, we will readdress previous challenges regarding low applicant count and incomplete applications.
3. During the 2016-2017 academic year, we had to extend the deadline for both the Special awards and the Fall 2017 Continuing Merit scholarship. This was not the case this time around. Nevertheless, both the number of Special Award and Fall Merit scholarship applicants were lower than last year: 25 this year compared to 32 last year for the Special Awards and 87 this year compared to 100 last year for the Fall Merit scholarship. Also, we continue to get a significant proportion of the applications at the deadline.
4. Having made the annual report ADA compliant, the committee continues to look for ways to efficiently edit the minutes and agendas to meet ADA compliance. The chair and secretary have attended a training session on ADA compliance that was organized by the academic senate steering committee. Additionally, the chair met with Athanasia Kalaitzidis from CUNY Assistive Technologies Services. Dave Moretti has also been helpful with suggestions for improvement.

Recommendations / To Do

1. There continues to be a need for reception of award information in a timely manner. The committee chairperson should receive the list of final selections of awards and scholarships reviewed by the committee as soon as the final choices are made to prepare the report.
2. As both the Fall Merit and Special Awards number of applicants dropped from the year before, there continues to be a need to improve how we advertise awards. Advertising at departmental meetings and events like Undergraduate research day could improve applicant counts.
3. **Academic Merit Scholarships:**
 - The committee discussed and approved an expansion of our recommendation choices to include
 - o Accepted but pending: not enough QCC accumulated credits. Waiting on the current semester grades.
 - o Denied but pending: not enough credits registered for Fall.
 - The committee continued to discuss ways of improving the screening of applications for the Merit scholarship. Anissa Moody suggested accomplishing this

through the creation of macros in Excel that will prefilter applications by factors such as GPA, and QCC credits completed.

4. **Special Awards:**

- There continues to be a need to verify account and balances of awards. The executive assistant to the Vice President should be contacted before the next call for Special awards.
- **The John F. Kennedy Award and the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Award accounts are empty.** However, the president continues to fund them through other monies because of the significance of the awards.

5. **Additional awards:**

The committee, as suggested by Sharon Lall-Ramnarine, discussed the idea of creating new institutional or departmental awards since the eligibility of the Special Awards is very limited. As mentioned by Veronika Lucas, such matters would have to be addressed and decided on by the president.

6. The committee will continue to address ADA compliance. Dave Moretti is currently working on templates for different agendas, minutes, and annuals for the academic senate committees. Also, Anissa Moody has recommended the creation of macros in Excel to make previous and future documents ADA compliant.

7. **Shared Network Drive needed:** As stated previously, this committee continues to need access to a shared network drive for digital file sharing as a means of collecting applications. The committee does have a Blackboard site but it was never utilized for this purpose. Google Drive or Dropbox may be preferred.

8. **Dates for advertising or soliciting applications and recommendations for awards and scholarships:**

- The **Spring 2019 Continuing Student Academic Merit Scholarships** need to be advertised early in the Fall 2018 semester. Ideally, the committee should meet in December 2018 to vote on these.
- **The Fall 2019 Continuing Academic Merit Scholarships** and Special Awards need to be advertised in April 2019. Ideally, the committee should meet in May 2018 to vote on both of these.

Acknowledgements

Dugweo Seo has continued to do an excellent job as the secretary of the committee. She promptly sends the chair the minutes after each meeting. She attended an ADA compliance training session with the chair. **Ewa Dabkowska** has shown great commitment in her first year on the committee. She attended both sessions in the Summer of 2017 to prepare for her term that started in Fall 2017. She always comes to the meetings well prepared and asks pertinent questions regarding the evaluation of applications. **Sharon Lall-Ramnarine** was helpful once again by offering great

advice and input as the former chair. She contributed to great discussions on which candidates should be awarded scholarships. She also brought up the possibility of creating new institutional or departmental awards. This is something the committee will inquire about in the future. **Anissa Moody** has provided great insight into possible ways of improving the screening process for the Merit scholarship and addressing ADA compliance in our documents that we post onto the website. She has suggested creating macros in Excel to make all documents ADA compliant and also to filter out Merit scholarship applications that do not meet the accumulated credits, GPA, and registration credit requirements. Our committee will consider these ideas in the future. **David Rothman** once again provided great assistance as an English professor in the evaluation of Merit scholarship essays and was a key participant in our discussions on candidates.

The committee would like to give a special thanks to Veronica Lukas and her staff for their meticulous work throughout the year by reserving the meeting room, setting up lunch, advertising the awards, and compiling all the applications for review. The voting sheet for the Merit scholarship has continued to improve over the last few years. The latest changes were the addition of columns for both the registered credits for the previous and upcoming semester, and two columns for the essay (content and grammar). This has made it easier to evaluate the merit applications.

We would also like to thank Dave Moretti and Athanasia Kalaitzidis for sharing their expertise in ADA compliance.

We would like to acknowledge the two outgoing members, Sharon Lal-Ramnarine and David Rothman for their many productive years on this committee.

Lastly, we would like to thank President Call for her endless support to this committee and her 47 years of dedicated service to QCC.
