- Review of November 12th, 2015 minutes –it was approved with a change (Kathleen Landy attended Mercy College online Conference)
- Bruce Naples report and update on following items

#### **Blackboard:**

- The next Bb upgrade is still on track for Sunday 12/27/15. The system will be down for 24 hours and it's expected to be up again on 12/28/15 at 2:00 pm. The upgrade will affect mostly the backend, no major changes are expected in the User Interface.
- Third-party tools, made available by attaching them to via Bb building block or LTI, continue to be added to Blackboard. For QCC, we now have VoiceThread, SoftChalk, and Starfish. We expect to have EduCanon after the Dec 27<sup>th</sup> update, and QCC is applying for Digication.
- Upgrades for the Blackboard will be 4 times a year instead of 2 times
- The Alternative LMS Sub-Committee of CUNY-CAT continues to conduct an evaluation to
  determine alternatives to Blackboard. Bruce Naples is a member of that sub-committee.
  INVITATION: As a testing methodology the ACC eLearning Team intends to select a few of the
  possible alternative LMS candidates, build an identical course within each environment, and
  then critique the process. If any member of the eLearning committee would like to participate in
  this exercise please let me know by email.

  continues to establish a New eLearning Institute structure- which will be on Fridays for next
  Spring.
- At the last meeting, the eTeam decided to support the notion of awarding digital badges to all students completing PNET and FNET courses. We also hope to work with CETL to possibly define HIP badges. A copy of different badges was circulated to members.
- The Institute Invitation / Application has been sent out by VP Marchese we await faculty applications the deadline is next Tuesday, Dec 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Bruce noted we have not gotten too many applications.
