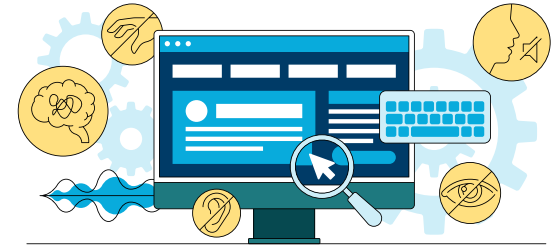
ACADEMIC SKILLS COACHING
